## Member Internal Audit App

Full contracting ARCA members can sign up to the Member Internal Audit App, so their internal audits use the same question set as an ARCA audit. Also, as an adaptation of the ARCA Site Audit App, the App scores audits automatically and provides a corrective action report. This App enables direct comparisons of ARCA external and internal audit results, so providing a strong management tool.

#### **Additional Audits**

ARCA audits are widely acknowledged within the industry for assessing key legal requirements, as well as promoting good practices, therefore, as part of its unique range of services ARCA offers members site audits on request.

These audits follow the same criteria as the ARCA audits and so provide a consistent form of measurement. Members can request ARCA to organise additional audits either; by arrangement, or unannounced, whereby there is no prior notice of an audit.

## Licence renewal preparation

Being fully prepared to make an asbestos licence renewal application is vital for asbestos removal businesses. As applications are made electronically, having all supporting documents available is essential, as shortfalls could delay the licence renewal process.

To support asbestos removal members, ARCA offers a licence renewal preparation service, which covers a full review of the removal contractor's systems and procedures to support the application. To deliver this service, ARCA has a team of in-house experts with extensive knowledge in auditing and regulatory requirements, together with the experience of former HSE inspectors.

#### Management system review

In recent years failure to demonstrate 'adequate management arrangements' has been a large factor in the decreasing number of asbestos licences granted. It is one of the most common concerns causing the HSE to review the status of existing asbestos licence holders.

To support members, ARCA can undertake a review of a business's management systems and structures to critically examine the way the business is functioning and check that business operations are on solid foundations.

The review examines the structure of the organisation; testing how well arrangements are defined and how closely they match actual practice. It will also test how well the business is able to demonstrate effective management arrangements, providing invaluable information on where improvements can be made.

Having the right systems in place is crucial. Robust management systems give confidence, and the principles of effective management support every aspect of a business to operate more efficiently.

Case Study: ARCA was approached by a company for input into a review of its management arrangements. Following analysis of systems, policies and procedures, and a review of site files, internal / external audits and inspections, ARCA was able to provide constructive advice on how to improve arrangements.

In tandem, ARCA worked with the company's HR consultant to ensure that newly developed HR processes fully supported asbestos licensing expectations. The company has now moved forward with confidence and the expectation of demonstrating vastly improved management arrangements to clients and the HSE.
